DAY 1: SINGAPORE → KATHMANDU

(D)

Depart from Singapore, Changi Airport at 08:20 by MI. Arrive Kathmandu airport at 12:05. Upon arrival, you will be met our staff and you will be transferred to Hotel. After short rest, we will visit the Swayambhunath Temple, said to be 2500 years Stupa on a hillock, which offers a breath-taking view of Kathmandu City and the Sunset view. This Stupa is the oldest of its kind in Nepal, listed in the UNESCO World Heritage Monument Listed in 1979. Next, we will visit historic Kathmandu Durbar Square (Hanuman Dhoka) if you are lucky, you will be able to have a glance of the famous living Goddess of Nepal name Kumari. Dinner will be served near hotel restaurant. After dinner you will be able to stroll along the busy street of Kathmandu city center. Overnight Kathmandu.

DAY 2: KATHMANDU → POKHARA BY COACH

(B/L/D)

After breakfast in hotel, depart from Kathmandu to Pokhara by coach (5-6hour) Passing through beautiful landscape, paddy farm, river, tiny villages etc. Pokhara is located 200 kilometer west of Kathmandu city. This is second largest city of Nepal. It is a most beautiful city with lakes and panoramic view of Annapurna Himalayan ranges. The Annapurnas and the famous "Fishtail" mountain peak of Machapuchare can be seen from Pokhara valley. Overnight stay in Pokhara.

DAY 3: POKHARA → SHARANKOT 1500m → POKHARA

(BLD)

Wake up early in the morning and short drive to Sarangkot to see sunrise, which is one of the most popular tourist spot of Nepal. Sharankot Hill top is situated at elevation of 1500 meter from sea level. It will offer magnificent view of snow capped mountain in the north & city view of Pokhara with beautiful lake. Later we will back to hotel for breakfast. After breakfast, we will set off for city tour, also called "Magic land or Dreamland" of Nepal. Devi's fall, Mahadev gupteswor Cave And Tibetan refugee camp, you can see at Tibetan refugee camp Their way of life specially the women knitting hand make carpet factory, which is best quality made from mountain goat's special wool. Later we will have lunch near Lakeside. After lunch, we will go for (Optional) mini trek up to the newly built World Peace Stupa. Up above at 1050m high, you will be able to see the beautiful heart shape Fewa Lake and the entire city view of Pokhara. Tonight you get to enjoy the beautiful Cultural Folk Dance while having a sumptuous dinner. Overnight stay in Pokhara.

DAY 4: POKHARA → KATHMANDU

(B/L/D)

Depart Pokhara to Kathmandu 200 KL by coach or domestic flight (USD 96 optional) upon arrival in Kathmandu, transfer check in to hotel. PM: we will visit Patan (Lalitpur) – which is the oldest of the three major cities in Kathmandu Valley – famous for its Buddhist monuments, Hindu temples, and you can catch the traditional artisans working with wood, stones and metals. Next, we'll proceed to visit Bouddhanath Stupa, this stupa is the largest in the Asia region and listed in the UNESCO World Heritage Sites at 1979. Overnight stay in Hotel.

DAY 5: KATHMANDU → NAGARKOT**(B/L/D)**

After breakfast, we will proceed to visit Pashupatinath Temple (5 km East of Kathmandu)

This ancient Hindu temple is one of the most sacred pilgrimages for Hindus, situated on the banks of the sacred Bagmati River. There are many occasions when the faithful take ritual purifier baths in the river. The temple of Lord Shiva, Pashupatinath, with a tiered golden roof & silver doors is famous for its superb architecture. The large gilded triple-roofed temple was built in 1696 AD though 300 years earlier there was a structure on this site. Entrance to the temple precinct is forbidden to non-Hindus though one can view from the terrace on the wooded hill across the river. This is the appropriate site to view the tradition of Hindu devotees along with the cremation. Drive to Nagarkot, 2300m above sea-level, this scenic spot, with a spectacular view of the sunset and Mount Everest can be seen on a clear day. In the evening, watch the sunset of the Himalayas at Nagarkot, Country Villa Hotel or similar.

DAY 6: NAGARKOT – (LOCAL VILLAGE TOUR)**(B/L/D)**

Today we spend full day in Nagarkot. Enjoy the view of the eastern Himalayas. Visiting local school, villages in the afternoon drive to viewpoint to see beautiful sunset view. Stay overnight at Nagarkot.

DAY 7: NAGARKOT → KATHMANDU**(B/L/D)**

We will awake to the beginning of a cold but stunningly spectacular dawn: the first rays of the sun firing the peaks a hellish red slowly lighting the Himalayas from Kachenjunga and Everest in the Far East to the Annapurnas and Dhaulagiri in the West. Drive to Kathmandu. Upon arrival in Kathmandu, check-in to the hotel. Lunch will be served in restaurant. After lunch, half day free and leisure for your final shopping. Stay overnight in Kathmandu.

DAY 08: KATHMANDU → SINGAPORE**(B)**

After breakfast, free at leisure till your transfer to the airport for your flight back to Singapore.
